### EMERGING DRUG TRENDS/DRUGS OF ABUSE

**INSTRUCTORS:** **Sgt. Troy Gielish** - Irvine PD. Troy has had years of experience in investigations of narcotics and persons under the influence of drugs. He is a certified DRE and DAR instructor and is a staff instructor for CNOA in the areas of DAR and Standardized Field Sobriety Testing Programs.

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** With the ever increasing number of new and non-traditional drugs being imported, manufactured, and used in today's drug culture, law enforcement is tasked with keeping up with these emerging drug trends. Many of these drugs, (MDMA, DMT, DXM, Kratom, Salvia Divinorum, LSD substitutes, etc.), are not covered in traditional drug training programs. Additionally, emerging drug trends in the club scene are not well known to law enforcement. This course will provide the student knowledge to identify these drugs, recognize the symptomology, methods of ingestion, and paraphernalia associated with the drugs, as well as discuss legal aspects pertaining to persons involved with them. The course will also discuss current trends in the club scene.

This unique class will be beneficial to all law enforcement officers regardless of assignment as well as those involved in P&P and criminal prosecution. **This class is POST Certified.**
